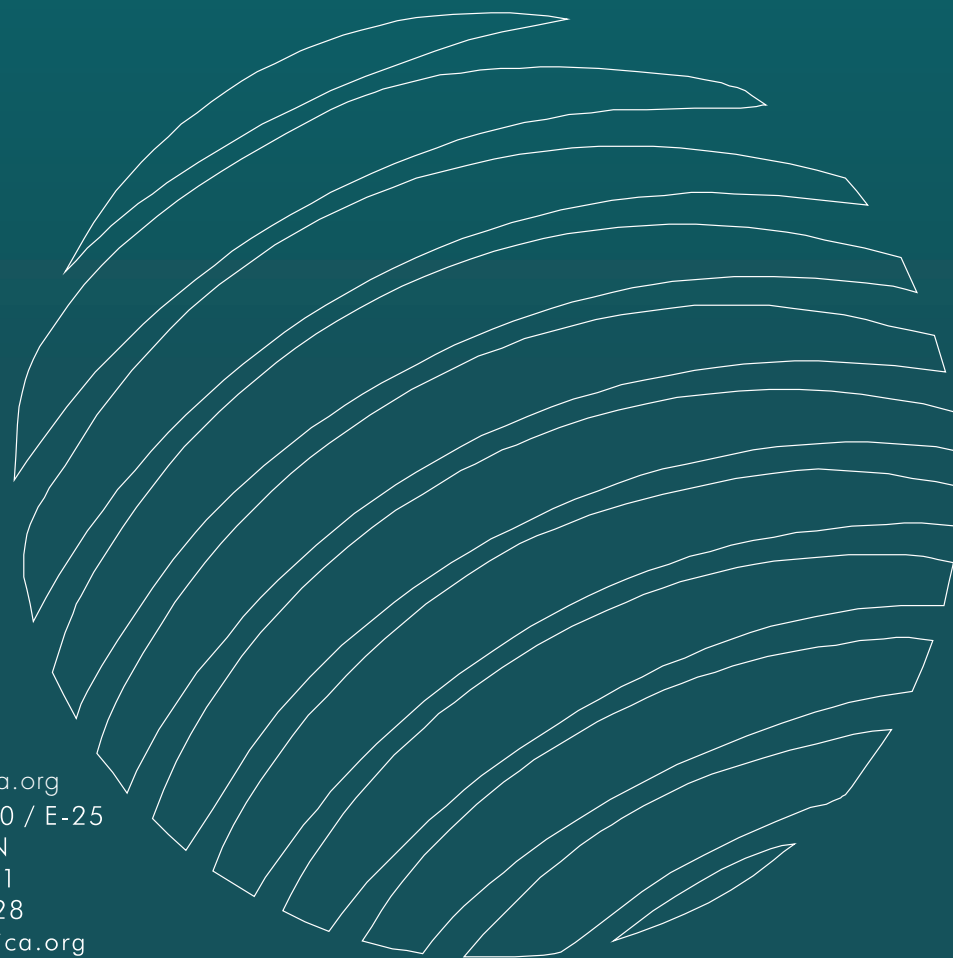


PROFESIONALES

Over the last few years, the international team of Profesionales por la Ética has developed an important and very active role in the defense of fundamental rights working with the international institutions and the main European networks. We participate in some of the main European organizational networks and work together with some of the leading lobbying entities related to the European Parliament, the Council of Europe, the European Court of Human Rights, the UN, the Fundamental Rights Agency and the OSCE. And we publish a monthly international newsletter .

Among other actions, we have participated as speakers at various international forums and institutions such as the European Parliament (June 2010), the OSCE meeting at Warsaw (October 2010) and Vienna (December 2010), and the FRA meeting at Vienna (2011).
